Miniature Vestments

These pattern pieces were designed by Jodi Bonjour (sewfearless@gmail.com) who writes at <http://www.sewfearless.com>. They are given as a gift to other catechists and teachers of the Catholic faith. This file does not include detailed directions, but project notes are given to aid an experienced or adventurous sewer in making their set.

- All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ inch unless otherwise noted.
- Print pattern pieces on 100% scale.
- This project is scaled to fit a 10 inch masculine decorative mannequin.

Amice

- made from men's handkerchief, and $\frac{3}{8}$ inch grosgrain ribbon
- cut two pieces 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches by 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches, for a finished size of 6 inches by 3 inches

Cincture

- a twisted cord made from DMC embroidery floss

Alb

- made from men's handkerchiefs
- 2 yoke pieces, 2 front/back pieces, 2 sleeves

Stole

- 2 pieces - 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches by 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches, for a finished size of 1 inch by 18 inches

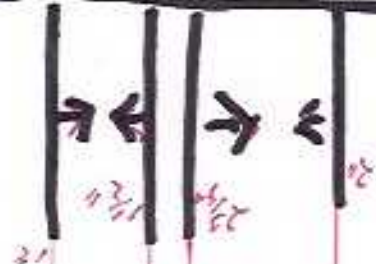
Chasuble

- 2 chasuble pieces, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch wide bias strip at least 7 inches for collar
- $\frac{5}{8}$ inch gold ribbon for accents
- The samples were made from a quilter's "fat quarter", better drape would be achieved from a higher quality apparel fabric.

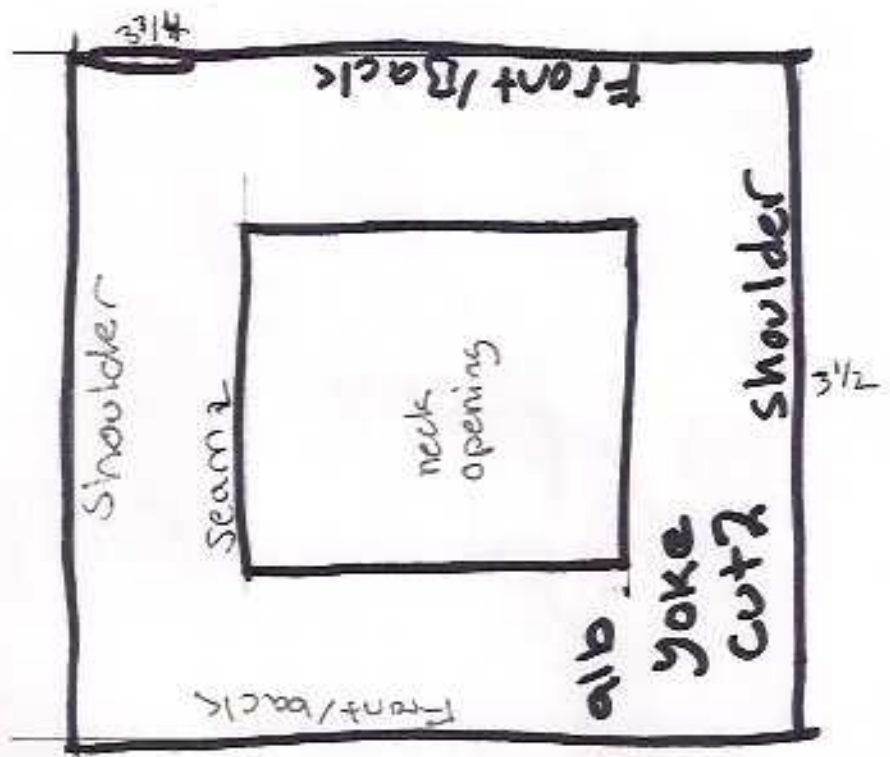

Chasuble
Cut 2 on fold

1/2 bias for collar
at least + 7"

- Construction
- ⑤ Sew ribbon (35" of ribbon per chasuble)
 - ① Sew one shoulder
 - ② Sew collar
 - ④ Second shoulder
 - ③ hem

1/4" narrow hem
